All Saints' College Student Attendance Policy

Students need to attend school on a regular basis to gain the maximum benefit from schooling in order to optimise their life opportunities. It is widely recognised that attendance problems are best managed by early identification and intervention. The School Education Act requires compulsory-age students, as defined in the Act, to attend school, or participate in an educational program of a school, on the days on which the school is open for instruction unless an arrangement in writing has been entered into. Parents are required to notify their intent and seek the approval of the Minister to allow their child to participate in any activity other than full time attendance at school until the end of the year in which that child turns 17. Absenteeism therefore, is viewed very seriously by All Saints' College. To comply with the Act, we require all enrolled students to attend College each day during term time and College events as stated in the calendar each year.

The College keeps accurate records by rigorously monitoring attendance of all students. Appropriate strategies are implemented to restore attendance if issues become evident. Attendance records are kept for each student enrolled at the College. This includes recording attendance during Tutor Group in the morning and recording attendance for every period during the school day in the Senior School. Attendance is noted twice each day in the Junior School, in the morning and again after lunch.

The Student Services Office monitors student absences and produces regular absence reports for Tutors, Head of House/Head of Transition and the Dean of Student Wellbeing. At any time when a student's absence is considered likely to interfere with the student's educational progress a number of steps will be taken by members of the Wellbeing Team to help address the issue/s.

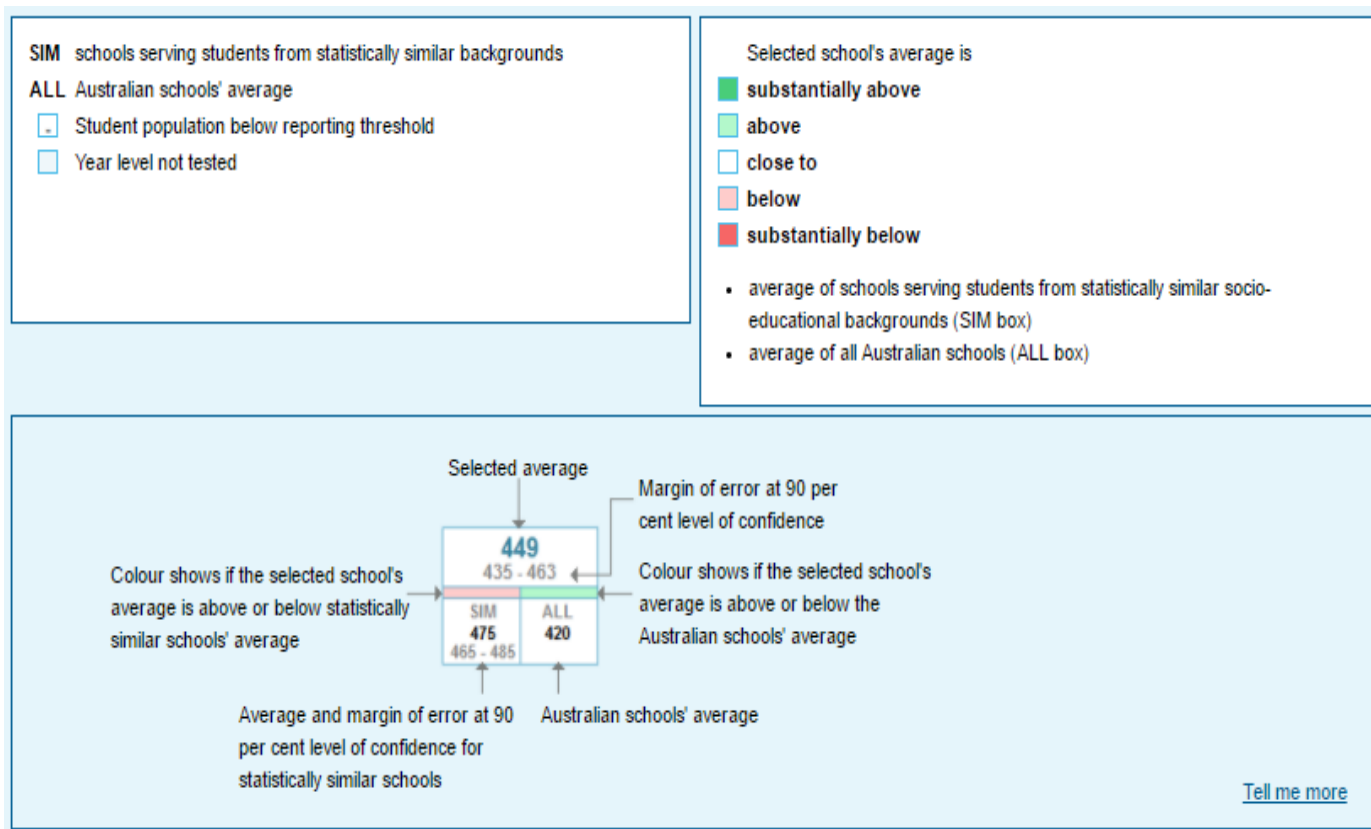

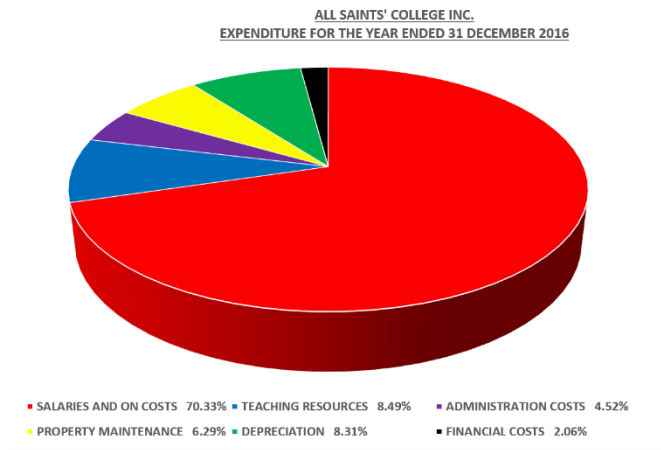
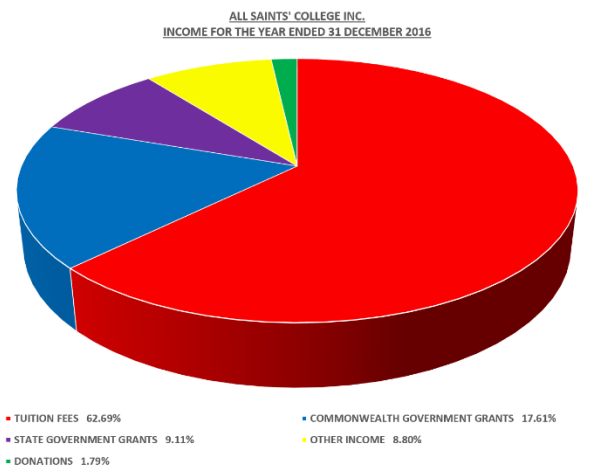

ASC Strategic Plan Goals

Goal 1: Optimised Student Learning: confident and engaged learners characterised by a growth mindset.

The College's 2016 parent satisfaction survey showed that 96.50% of all respondents felt pleased with the curriculum provided.
