Students need to attend school on a regular basis to gain the maximum benefit from schooling in order to optimise their life opportunities. It is widely recognised that attendance problems are best managed by early identification and intervention.

Absenteeism therefore, is viewed very seriously by All Saints' College. We require all enrolled students to attend College each day during term time and College events as stated in the calendar each year.

The College keeps accurate records by rigorously monitoring attendance of all students. Appropriate strategies are implemented to restore attendance if issues become evident. Attendance records are kept for each student enrolled at the College. This includes recording attendance during Tutor group in the morning and recording attendance for every period during the school day (*in Senior School*).

The Student Services Office monitors student absences and produces regular absence reports for Tutors, Head of House/Head of Transition and the Dean of Student Wellbeing. At any time when a student's absences is considered likely to interfere with the student's educational progress a number of steps will be taken by members of the Wellbeing Team to help address the issue/s.

9. ATAR Results 2014

Almost 14% of eligible All Saints' College students obtained an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR) of 99 or more, putting them in the top one per cent of students across the state.

More than 38% of eligible students achieved an ATAR of 95 or above.

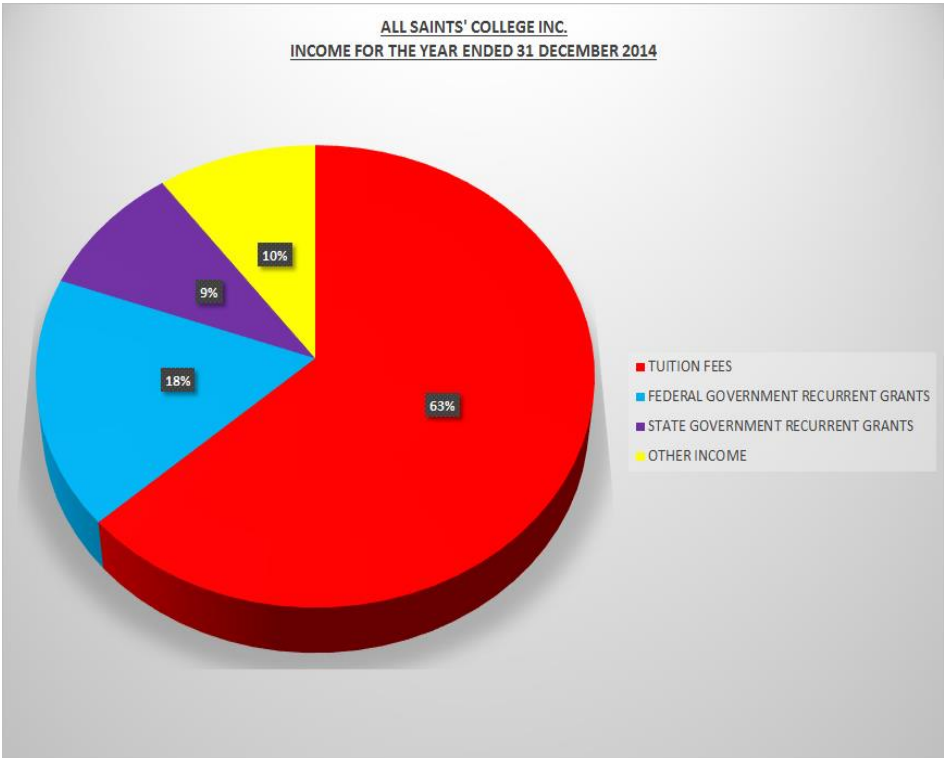
55% of our eligible students achieved an ATAR of 90 or above.

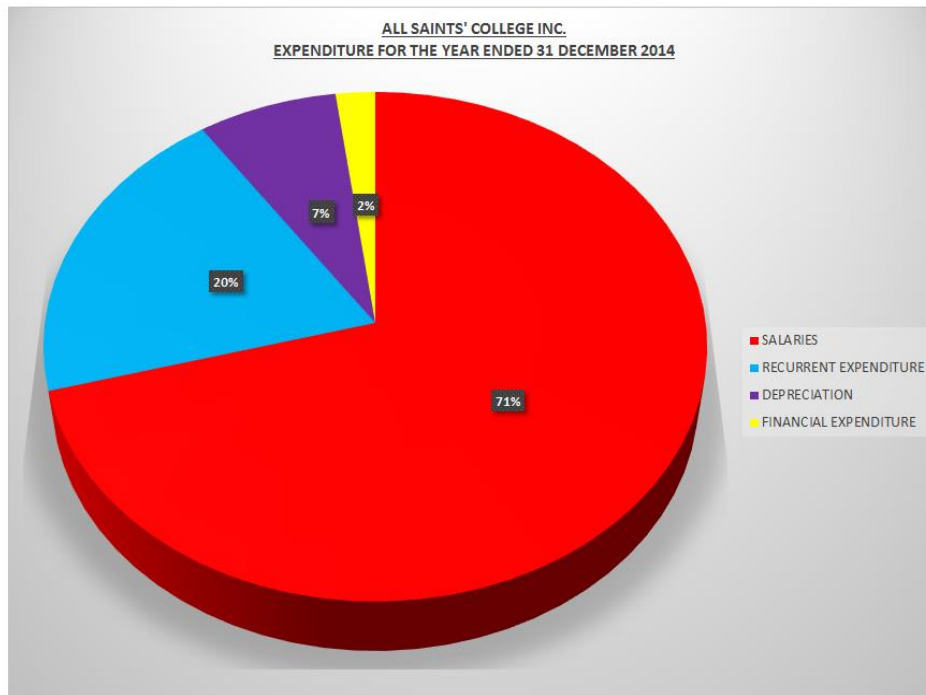
All Saints' College's median ATAR was 92.35.
