## All Saints' College students collaborate with ceramic artist Andrea Vinkovic on Sculpture by the Sea project

ALL Saints' College students will cast special attention over the 2018 Sculpture by the Sea exhibition, having collaborated with ceramic artist Andrea Vinkovic on her submission.



Students in Years 4 to 10 took part in workshops where they proposed ideas and created prototypes for the lighting element of the piece, a combination of ceramics and electronics that mimic neurons in the brain.



Vinkovic said the workshops involved looking at ideas and inspiration for the work, experimenting with lights and making a model of the sculpture.

"It is certainly a thought-provoking and engaging process that will have a lasting influence, hopefully positive, for everyone involved," she said.

The workshops were part of the school's centre for innovation and entrepreneurship, Propeller Enterprises, and community arts initiative, the HotHouse Company, which links young performers with leading artists and companies.
