## MURDOCH MONEY

Today is the last day Year 12 students can apply to Murdoch University, without incurring a late fee, for a special scholarship that will pay them up to \$3000 to help them ease into uni life.

The scholarship program was introduced last year to attract high-achieving students to Murdoch and offers a \$2000 grant to students with an ATAR

above 80 and \$3000 for kids with an ATAR above 90.

Law and accounting student Jordanna Petersen was one of 400 students to receive a grant last year and said the money came in handy for those up-front uni costs, such as textbooks and parking permits.

"When you begin university there's an expectation that you're becoming more financially independent and that's not always an easy adjustment to make," Petersen said.

The Murdoch First Scholarship program is being expanded this year to assist even more students embarking on their tertiary education journey.
