A lot riding on tradition: The Bull Creek-Leeming church will be holding its annual Palm Sunday procession on March 25.

Palm Sunday tradition rides on

THE All Saints' Anglican Church of Bull Creek-Leeming will continue its Palm Sunday Procession tradition on March 25.

Members of the church have walked from Brockman Park in Bull Creek back to the chapel at All Saints' College annually since 2014.

The procession features donkeys, which Reverend Bruce Hyde said attracted quite a bit of interest.

"The procession is an opportunity for Christians to relive the moment when Jesus entered Jerusalem in the week prior to his crucifixion and to offer acts of praise and worship to Christ the King," he said.

"Jesus came into Jerusalem riding on the back of a donkey and his followers welcomed him with great acclamation, waving palm branches and laying their cloaks on the road.

"Palm Sunday, also known as Passion Sunday, marks the beginning of Holy Week and on this day the scene is set for the unfolding of this climactic event in Jesus' life, as God's salvation for all the world unfolds."

A sausage sizzle will be held after the service, with a magician providing entertainment. The donkeys will stick around too.

The parish will meet at Brockman Park at 8.30am.
