A student visit to Fitzroy Crossing, as part of 'Voices', the college's service/arts initiative, was a privilege and joy. A team of students and staff spent the week recording the stories of significant members of the Bayulu and Fitzroy Valley communities. This will be shared as an artistic representation of this rich and deep history and heritage, and is an experience that has taught the All Saints' students and staff so much. This was one of three service trips, and the college's third annual Fitzroy Crossing Service Learning Immersion expedition. It's part of the college's 'H3: Heads, Hearts and Hands' programme and an important way we empower our students to become connected, confident and compassionate members of society. Helping them make a positive difference to the lives of others, and learning about themselves in the process.

In partnership with Teach Learn Grow, our students provided one-on-one tutoring and mentoring to students at the Bayulu Remote Community School and, for the first time, due to the popularity of this programme, worked alongside students at a second school, the Muludja Remote Community School. This experience provides an opportunity for the college to further develop our partnerships and share the gift of education with the children of Bayulu and Muludja.
